Rohling also discussed blocked or collapsed tile creating drainage issues and water in the basement. Cavey noted that he felt the City has not plugged a tile that would create an issue. Mayor Schnede will look at the issue.

**Dog complaint** – discussed various issues and complaints with the owners. Further issues will be addressed on an as need basis. No action was taken at this time.

Jill Bachus, Head Librarian – discussed plans for the Summer Reading Program.

A motion to approve **the annual street closing on Fridays after 4 p.m.** between JR's Place and the bank from April 15<sup>th</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup> was made by P. Stankee with a second by C. Stankee. All ayes.

At 6:55 p.m. a motion to open the public hearing regarding the 2018 budget amendment was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

No oral or written comments were made.

At 6:56 p.m. a motion to close the public hearing regarding the 2018 budget amendment was made by C. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

A motion to approve **resolution 2018-14** which is for the approval of the 3<sup>rd</sup> budget amendment to the 2018 budget was made by Wiese. With a second by P. Stankee. All ayes.

A motion to approve the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of **ordinance 183-18** which is for the water rate increase effective with the July 1, 2018 billing cycle was made by Wiese with a second by P. Stankee. All ayes.

A motion to approve the 3<sup>rd</sup> reading of **ordinance 184-18** which is for the garbage and recycling rate increase effective with the July 1, 2018 billing cycle was made by C. Stankee with a second by Wiese, All aves.

A motion to approve **resolution 2018-15** which is for the 2019 fiscal year city employee wages was made by C. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

A motion to approve the bridge inspection contract with Calhoun & Burns was made by P. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

Ganzer attended the Clinton County Board of Supervisors meeting on April 2<sup>nd</sup> along with Chandra Ravada of ECIA and County Engineer, Todd Kinney. The Clinton County Board of Supervisors has agreed to support a small cites funding SWAP to help Wheatland obtain the \$270,000.00 in funding with an interest free loan for 20 years. In addition

the City will apply for the Rural County Transportation Grant in the amount of \$25,000.00. Ganzer thanked the BOS for their support of Wheatland. Specifics and approval will be reported on at a later date.

A motion to approve **resolution 2018-16** which is for approval of the application for the filing a Rural County Transportation Grant was made by C. Stankee with a second by Wiese. All ayes.

**Reports** – Ganzer reported that single stream recycling will not happen through WGML. Grand Mound and Wheatland can form a 28E agreement for the purpose of recycling and apply for SWAP grants to fund the purchasing for the containers and the truck.
